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INFORMATION ON GENERAL ELECTIONS TO MUNICIPALITIES IN ORISSA - 1997

There are 102 Urban Local Bodies in the State. Consequent upon the 74th Constitution Amendment Act, the Orissa Municipal (Amendment) Act, 1994 was passed. Thereafter election for the 5 (nominated) Councils of Burla, Belpahar, Balimela, Sunabeda and Paradeep were held in April, 1995 under the superintendence, direction and control of the State Election Commission. The partywise break up of Councillors in these 5 U.L.Bs is shown in Annexure-1.

2. The Orissa Legislative Assembly in their Resolution dated 1.8.1995 dissolved 97 Municipal Councils. 5 N.A.Cs where elections were held in April, 1995, were excluded from the purview of the said Resolution.

3. The general elections to three tier Panchayats were held in January/February, 1997. Thereafter, bye-elections to one Parliamentary Constituency and 2 Assembly constituencies were announced by the Election Commission of India. Then the State Election Commission notified an election schedule for 97 Urban Local Bodies which is at Annexure-2.

- (a) In Titilagarh NAC, no nomination was filed by any candidate in protest against non-fulfilment of certain local demands by the Government. Accordingly, election process in Titilagarh NAC has been stopped for the time being.
- (b) In Kavisuryanagar NAC, for 16 wards, there was no contest as all the 16 Councillors were returned unopposed.
- (c) In Sambalpur Municipality because of certain defects in reservation of wards, the election could not be conducted and was postponed. Subsequently, an election schedule for Sambalpur Municipality was drawn up by the Commission which is at Annexure-3. On the day of poll on 4.8.97, due to heavy rainfall the poll was stopped at 2 P.M. Continuation poll was therefore held on 10th August, 1997 from 9 A.M. to 12 Noon. Counting of votes took place on 11th August, 1997.

4. In 13 booths of six wards in 5 Municipalities, fresh poll was ordered by the Commission, details of which is at Annexure-4. Counting of vote was taken up on the day following the date of fresh poll.

5. After the stipulated date of withdrawal of candidature, in 64 wards in 24 Municipalities, because of single nomination, 64 Councillors were elected uncontested; details of which is at Annexure-5.

6. In 14 wards of 13 Municipalities vide Annexure-6, no nomination was filed. All these wards were reserved for different categories of persons. As provided under Sec.11(5) of the Orissa Municipal Act 1950 read with the Proviso to Rule 32(b), Government is to nominate suitable persons as Councillors.

7. Although election was scheduled to be held in 1582 wards in 97 Municipalities, because of various reasons poll was held in 1489 nos. of wards.

8. The details of electors, number of wards, candidates of different political parties contesting for the office of Councillors are at Annexure-7.

9. The number of Councillors elected party-wise and Municipality-wise is at Annexure-8.

10. (a) Indirect election for the post of Chairpersons and Vice-Chairpersons were held on 19.7.97 and 23.7.97. In Sambalpur Municipality, Chairperson was elected on 14.8.97 and Vice-Chairperson on 18.8.97. The names of the Chairpersons and Vice-Chairpersons of Urban Local Bodies are at Annexure-9 and Annexure-10 respectively.

(b) In Joda Municipality, election to the office of Chairperson (which was reserved for S.T. women) and Vice-Chairperson could not be conducted as no nomination was filed.

11. A statement indicating pattern of distribution of votes in favour of different political parties and independent candidates is at Annexure - 11.

12. In the meantime, steps have been taken to hold the bye-elections to fill up the casual vacancies occurring in 5 Wards due to different reasons.

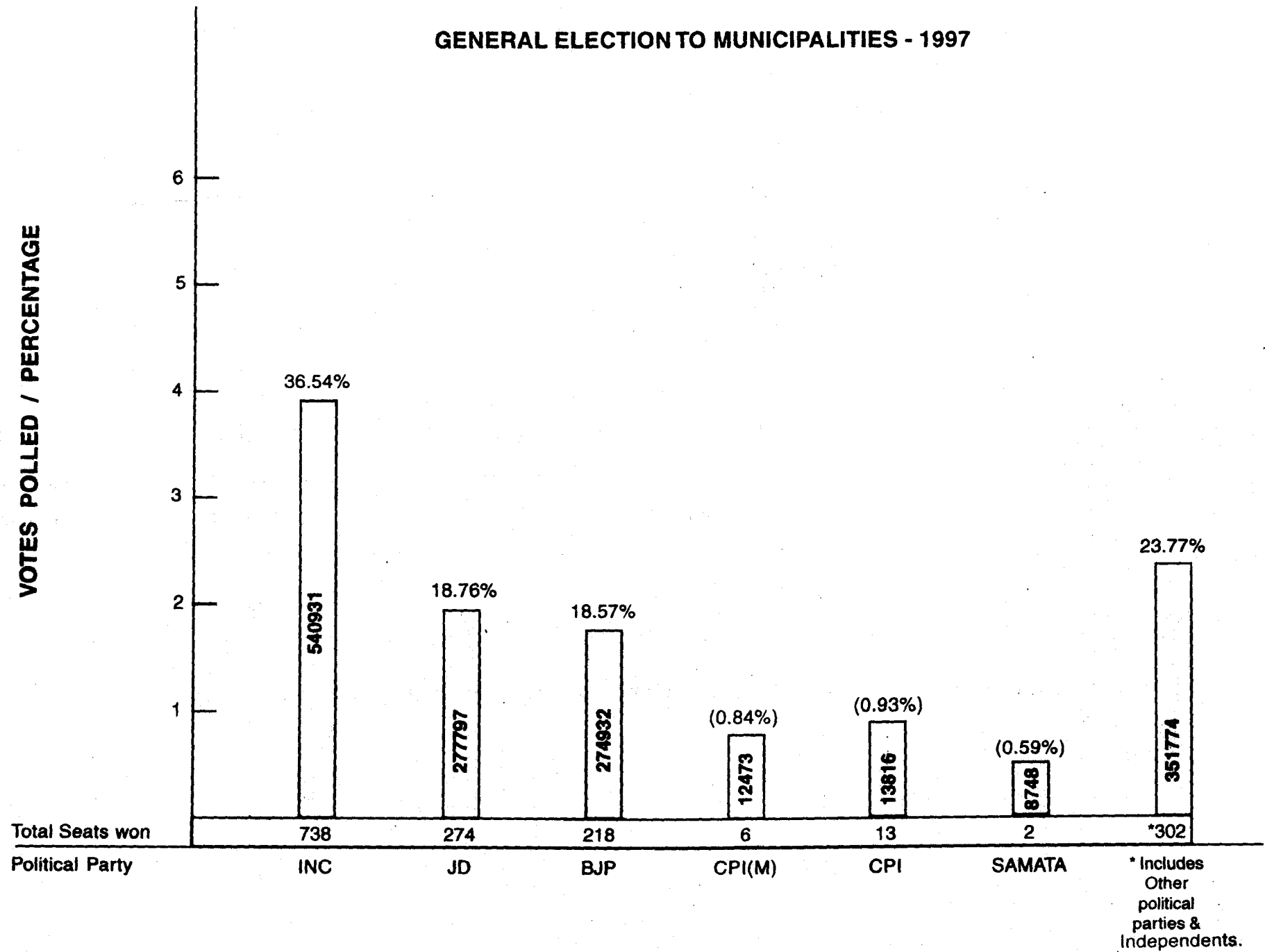
